LETTER TO PARENTS/CARERS

Dear Parent / Carer

I am delighted to be able to launch Eckington School's Activities Week Brochure for 2018. Activities Week will run from Monday 2nd July to Friday 6th July 2018. Some activities may run over the weekend before or after the dates mentioned.

Activities Week will provide your son or daughter with a wonderful opportunity to get involved in and experience an exciting activity of their preference. The aim of the week is to provide a variety of new and interesting opportunities to help your child develop their social, emotional and cultural skills.

The committed staff at Eckington School will lead the activities along with other qualified professionals where necessary.

In order for your son or daughter to be allocated and participate in their chosen activity, it is essential that you adhere to the payment deadlines. Some activities have a limited number of places and therefore allocation will be decided on a random selection basis. In the unfortunate situation that a student's first choice is unavailable, we will endeavour to offer their second choice activity therefore it is essential that all students think seriously about both of their choices to avoid disappointment.

For those activities which have a cost attached we ask parents/carers for a financial contribution. If it is not possible to cover the cost of the activity it will not be possible for the trip to run. Some activities are residential and others are based at Eckington School. It is essential that your child is entirely committed to the activity chosen because he/she will not be allowed to change once the booking form is handed in. Some activities require a good level of physical fitness so please ensure that your child is aware of their chosen activity's requirements. When considering the suitability of an activity for your child, please carefully consider the activity description contained in the Activities Week Brochure. Once your child's place is confirmed, the group leader will send you the relevant forms and payment details (if any), including a medical consent form to complete and return.

For activities that are residential, the group leaders will hold an information evening prior to departure. Further information regarding this evening will follow.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS / CARERS

Payments

All deadlines for payments must be adhered to. Verbal reminders will be given to your child and publicised on the school website. If payment deadlines are missed we will assume that your child no longer wishes to be involved in that activity and he/she will be placed onto a subsidised activity, depending on the suitability of the activity and the availability of places. You and your child will be informed in advance of the alternative activity.

All booking forms must be returned by **Friday 6th October 2017**. If your child's booking form is not returned by this date, your child is less likely to participate in an activity of their preference.

All payments made for Activities Week are non-refundable and only transferable to another activity if there are places available. For residential activities, payments are forwarded to tour operators. For local and school based activities the cost of specialist performers/teachers/transport etc has to be paid in advance. If unforeseen circumstances arise and you are no longer able to pay for the activity in full by the dates outlined, you must immediately inform the relevant group leader.

Payment deadlines for activities that cost:

- First deposit to be paid by: **Friday 20th October 2017***
- Second deposit to be paid by: **Friday 9th February 2018**
- Final balance to be paid by: **Thursday 22th March 2018**

* The **“Fun in the Sun”** activity will require a **£100** deposit to be paid with the booking form by **Friday 6th October 2017**.

Daily arrangements during activities week:

During Activities Week normal school bus services will operate. Students are expected to meet their group leader in a pre-arranged place for 8.45am. Information about transport will be communicated to students and parents/carers in advance. Students will end their activity at 3.15pm. Some activities may require students to arrive earlier to school and they may arrive back later than 3.15pm. Where this may be the case it is the responsibility of the parent or carer to ensure that safe provision is made for your son / daughter to get to and from school. Please note that staff will not wait for students who are late, so it is essential that your child arrives promptly. If your child misses their activity, you will not be entitled to a refund.

Lunchtime arrangements:

During Activities Week lunch will be from 12.35pm – 1.30pm. You will need to ensure that there is enough money on their Parent Pay account to buy a meal and a drink. Alternatively, students may also bring a packed lunch. Some offsite activities may require students to either take a packed lunch or money for refreshments throughout the day. Information about lunchtime arrangements will be communicated to students and their parents/carers in advance. It is absolutely essential that your child has enough food and drink during the week. If your child receives a free school meal, please indicate on the booking form below so that arrangements can be made for a meal to be provided for your child.

Expectations of students:

Throughout Activities Week students must maintain our high standards of respect . At any time prior to the event, group leaders and the Headteacher reserve the right to withdraw your child from their activity if they breach the school's behaviour policy and/or behave in any way which could endanger the health and safety of themselves and/or others (a refund will not be available).

For residential trips students will be required to sign a behaviour contract prior to departure. It is essential that your child adheres to health and safety guidelines and the school's behaviour policy. In accordance with the Derbyshire County Councils' drug policy, alcohol, smoking and substance misuse are **strictly prohibited**.

Once a student has opted for an activity they will **not be allowed to change**. Final details of Activities Week may change depending on the number of students opting for the activity and its financial viability. If, in the unfortunate event we do not get enough students on an activity, you will be given your deposit back and asked to opt for another activity.
