However, due to some technical issues with Weduc, we have had to temporarily disable the Weduc App while some necessary maintenance and improvements take place. We hope to have the Weduc App up and running again shortly after the October half term holiday. At this point, I will write to you all again to formally introduce the benefits of this application, our ideas going forward and how to register and make use of the Weduc App.
