What is NCS?

Autumn NCS is a programme exclusively for sixth form students. It is a chance to gain new life experience while trying new activities along the way. NCS takes place over 5 days in the October half term and is all based in the local area. With this programme being designed especially for sixth form students, it helps get them ready for life after school including university and apprenticeships. Young people who take part in NCS stand a 25% better chance of securing a place at university, and it is recommended by UCAS to put on personal statements. NCS also looks great on CVs and is recognised by hundreds of national businesses, which also offer exclusive work opportunities for NCS graduates.
